



**Langabúð museum and café:** Langabúð, originally dating back to 1790, is Djúpivogur's oldest building. Now renovated, it serves as a cultural centre for Djúpivogur, partly by housing a local museum along with a café. **Eggin í Gleðivík** is a new outdoor artwork made by the Icelandic artist Sigurður Guðmundsson. The artwork consists of thirty four eggs, one representing each species of local birds. The eggs are all similar in size except for one, which is the largest one and belongs to the red – throated diver, the characteristic bird of Djupivogur. From the centre of the village it is easy to access the "Eggin í Gleðivík" which is located in Gleðivík, about 900 meters walking distance from the centre of the village.

**Djupivogur Swimming Pool - SPA:** Gym, sauna and a newly built indoor swimming pool with hot tubs, a small pool for children, and another small pool outside. Opening hours: Summer: Mon-Fri, 7:00-20:30; Sat-Sun, 10:00-18:00.

**Papeyjarferðir:** Daily from 1 June to 15 September. Departs at 13:00 from the Djúpivogur marina. This trip, which lasts about 4 hours, goes past the bird cliffs at Papey and gives you the chance of seeing seals on nearby reefs. The guided hike on the island, which is part of the tour, will take you to Iceland's oldest and smallest wooden church. **Breiðdalur**  
The friendly valley of Breiðdalur is surrounded by majestic alpine mountains rising on both sides to over 1100 meters. The view of Breiðdalur from Breiðdalsheiði, an ancient eroded volcano on the Ring road, over the impressive Breiðdalsá river, famous for salmon-fishing, winds its way across the valley basin to the sea is great. Stop and search for colorful semi-precious stones and enjoy the healthy walks. The lovely arctic forest "Jörvíkurskógur" is a good place to stop and allows camping. Breiðdalsvík, the charming village boasts the coast view of great seascapes and black sand beaches. The first house was built in 1883 and soon drew more people. The old Co-op still exists, and now houses "The George Walker geological centre" on the Breiðdalur regions volcanic history and a collection dedicated to the linguist Stefán Einarsson and his research on the Icelandic language. The new Co-op now serves as a souvenir shop and café. In Breiðdalur you will find accommodation to meet your needs as well as coffee shops, restaurants and arts and craft markets. The main activities are horse riding with Odin tours, fishing for trout or salmon, bird-watching and hiking.

#### Museums in Fjarðabyggð

**Norðfjörður** The Museum House, houses three wonderful and equally distinct museums.  
**Eskifjörður** The East Iceland Maritime Museum, displays a reminders of local trade, industry and medicine in a well preserved trading house from 1816. Randulff's Seahouse, a beautifully preserved shore-building from 1830 with artefacts and a lingering atmosphere of times long gone.  
**Reyðarfjörður** The Icelandic Wartime Museum lets you travel back to the days of the occupation of the Allied Forces of Reyðarfjörður.  
**Fáskrúðsfjörður** Les Français en Islande, an interesting museum about the era of French fishermen in this area and a cosy café with French nuances on the menu.

June to August museum in Fjarðabyggð are open daily from 10:00 – 17:00 except Les Français en Islande which is open daily from 10:00 – 18:00.

**Summer festivities in Fjarðabyggð**  
**June 2** The Sailor's Day. Traditional festivity celebrating the strong maritime ties of the community.  
**June 22 – 29** Hiking Week in Fjarðabyggð. Eight consecutive days of mountaineering, hiking and entertainment in the evenings. A family friendly event with a Nature and Fun programme for the youngest ones.  
**June 30** Occupation Day (Reyðarfjörður). A colourful event reviving the times occupation of the Allied Forces in World War II.  
**July 10 – 13** Eistnaflug Hard Rock Festival (Neskaupstaður). Three days of heavy metal music the Icelandic way.  
**July 12 – 14** Pólar. A natural art and handicraft event in Stöðvarfjörður.  
**July 26 – 28** Les jours français. A family camping weekend at the French rooted town of Fáskrúðsfjörður.  
**August 2 – 5** Neistaflug (Neskaupstaður). A traditional Icelandic family camping weekend.



**Egilsstaðir and FljótSDalshérað**  
Egilsstaðir is the principal township of FljótSDalshérað and the service and transport centre of East Iceland. The town's strategic location makes it perfect to plan daytrips to many of the great attractions nearby.  
In Egilsstaðir is a great outdoor swimmingpool.  
Open June – August: Mon.-Fri. 06.30-21.30, weekends 10.00-18.00.  
The Slaughterhouse culture centre is the heart of culture and arts in Egilsstaðir and offers a variety of cultural events all year long.  
Open Mon.-Thurs. 17:00-22:00 (and special events).  
In Egilsstaðir you will also find the East Iceland heritage museum where the main exhibition covers rural Iceland in the late 19th and early 20th century.

This delightful area at the upper end of Lagarfljót lake takes pride in several of Iceland's leading natural attractions and historical sites, as well as a variety of tourist services. The area includes Iceland's largest forest, its second-highest waterfall, the most powerful hydroelectric station, unique buildings and other cultural features, and a visitor centre for Europe's biggest national park. For accommodation, you can select from well-equipped campgrounds, a good hotel, detached huts, or holiday apartments with cooking facilities or even in the highlands. As for food, you can enjoy delicious dishes at restaurants featuring local ingredients such as wild mushrooms, berries and reindeer. Some of the recreation options are to hire a horse, ATV or bicycle, or perhaps a boat for rowing on the lake for a glimpse of the famous Lagarfljót Wyrn and the view to Iceland's highest mountain outside of the major glaciers, Snæfell (1833 m).

**Borgarfjörður eystri** and the surrounding area are known for great natural beauty. The village Bakkagerði provides tourists with good services ([www.borgarfjordureystri.is](http://www.borgarfjordureystri.is)).

The "Víknaðlóðir" trails leading to the deserted fjords and coves has become a "Hiker's Paradise", with numerous trails marked, comfortable hiking huts and a good hiking-map. The marked trails range from 1hr to a full day, with highlights such as Dyrfjöll – Stóruð and Brúnavík.

According to folklore Borgarfjörður is the home of the Queen of Elves and you can visit Álfaborg "The Elves Castle" where the Queen holds her court. Visit Álfacafé and try the local fish-dishes or look at some of the beautiful handicraft by the local people.

In Bakkagerði you can stop at Kjarvalsstofa and see an interesting exhibit on the life and works of Jóhannes Kjarval one of Iceland's most celebrated painters. You can also visit the small "Adventureland" a folklore centre for children.

In Borgarfjörður, there are excellent facilities for bird-watching and a special hide at the harbour from which over twenty species have been sighted at once. At Hafnarhólmi, by the harbour for small boats, is one of Iceland's best locations for viewing puffins close up ([www.puffins.is](http://www.puffins.is)).

The last weekend in July, Braeðslan, one of the most popular summer concerts in Iceland is held in Borgarfjörður. Numerous musicians, both Icelandic and international, perform into the bright summernight ([www.braedslan.is](http://www.braedslan.is)).



**The village of Vopnafjörður** is on Kolbeinstanga, with varied opportunities for relaxation and outdoor activities. Many marked walking trails lead through Vopnafjörður's natural pearls. One of them, "the elephant", is a rock pillar on the east side of Vopnafjörður.

Two celebrations will be in Vopnafjörður in 2013: Vopnaskak, a family-oriented holiday with many activities, from 4.-7. July, and a cultural celebration, "Once upon an August evening", in honor of the brothers Jónas and Jón Múla, held 5.-11. August.

Kaupvangur Cultural Center is worth a visit: visitor information, Kaupvangskaffi, Múlastofa (an exhibit about the life and music of two brothers, Jónas and Jón "Múla"), and East Iceland Emigration Center providing information about 19th century emigrants. The Kaupvangur is open 10:00 – 18:00 daily in the summer.

In Hofsdáldal is the old farm Bustarfell, one of Iceland's best-kept turf houses whose uniqueness lies in its clear image of farming practices and lifestyle from before 1770 until 1966. The museum is open daily through the summer, 10:00 – 18:00. Café Croft is next door.

The golf course is nine holes whose layout is determined by its surroundings: steep hillside, diagonal layout and whimsical.

The Selárdal swimming pool, on the banks of the river where it runs through a shallow canyon, is famous for its lovely surroundings. About 12 km. north of the village, open daily 7:00 – 23:00.

Vopnafjörður's campground is small and peaceful, in a lovely setting overlooking the village. All basic services are available for vehicles, trailers and tents.
